### Larissa McGowan

Larissa began her dance training at the Queensland Dance School of Excellence and joined Australia Dance Theatre in 2000. She has toured extensively with ADT and appeared in many major works. In 2008 Garry Stewart named Larissa Associate Choreographer. Her work *Zero-sum* made its world premiere at WOMADelaide 2009. She followed this up with a highly successful appearance as a guest choreographer on two seasons of *So You Think You Can Dance*. Her work *Slack*, performed by ADT, was part of the Sydney Opera House's New Breed season, she created *Transducer* with Tasdance, made *Fanatic* for Sydney Dance Company, and her full length work *Skeleton* premiered in the 2013 Adelaide Festival. Winner of the 2004 Australian Dance Award for Outstanding Female Dancer, 2014 ADA finalist as Independent Choreographer, TEDx speaker, movement consultant, teacher of youth dancers and teachers – and amazing.

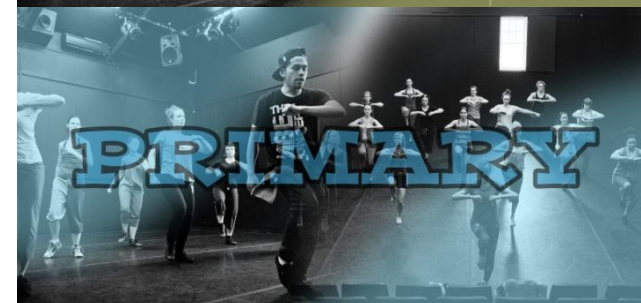
