

The show title for Ausdance ACT's Youth Dance Festival 2018 is:

 - "Who inspires you? Why? What have they done to leave their mark on the world. If you could do anything at all, what would it be? What do you love most in life? Helping? Solving problems? Being around lots of people? Who do you look up to or admire? Why?"
 - The Invictus Games, local heroes, news stories, celebrities, artists that have made their mark on their world. Research everyday heroes through to internationally recognised people.
