Ausdance ACT supports engagement of locally-based dance professionals (choreographers, teachers, directors, producers, performers, speakers and tutors).

Ausdance ACT is committed to employing or engaging appropriately qualified and experienced, locally-based, and other professional dance artists.

Ausdance ACT currently employs, on a part-time basis, professional dance artists and teachers in our core team. Ausdance ACT does not exclude dance artist or dance teacher members of the core team from being engaged also, on a casual basis, in any of Ausdance ACT's programs provided –

- i. the team member's skills and experience are the best available at the time for the fee; and*
- ii. the Manager considers that engaging a core team member for the requirement is in Ausdance ACT's best interests at the time.*
